Our Location

Euroweek is happening simultaneously in three different hotels in Bystrzyca, Klodsko Poland. The location of the program is about 2 hours away from Prague, Czech Republic and 3 hours from Berlin, Germany. Bystrzyca, Klodsko is a village of more or less 10,000 Polish residents. This is one of the mountainous region of Poland.

The program offers assistance in facilitating the requirements for Schengen Visa to Poland. Free standard Polish food during working days. Free accommodation with wi-fi together with other youth volunteers across the globe. About 180 euro (760PLN) allowance will be provided for pocket money.

Volunteers will shoulder roundtrip plane ticket, travel insurance and visa fee to Poland.
