ABOUT THE PROJECT

Multimedia Ninjas will gather three volunteers from Ukraine, Romania, and Latvia, with the aim of giving them a learning experience and enhancing their employability. Through the project, volunteers will contribute to the development of Socialna Akademija and to the wellbeing of the local community, well as promote international as mobilities among local youth. Volunteers will learn how to independently use multimedia tools (video, photography and digital media) and improve their skills in project work (planning, implementation, and evaluation).

When? 1st September 2018 – 3oth June 2019

The main tasks and activities of volunteers

- Organizing different events (workshops, trainings, camps etc.),
- helping in workshops and youth activities,
- creating photo, video and promo materials,
- promotion of Erasmus+ and volunteering opportunities (Facebook, blog, website management),
- community work,
- administrative tasks, and
- developing their own projects.



Volunteers will learn

- How to use a camera, create videos and photos;
- how to use Wordpress and manage websites;
- how social media work and how to use it in youth work;
- organisational and coordination skills needed in project work;
- how to use graphic and other digital programs (Adobe suite, Canva, Google tools, Podio, etc.);
- how to create promotional material;
- an in-depth knowledge of Erasmus+ and other international mobility possibilities;
- how to write a project and possibilities for public funding;
- technical and DIY skills;
- leadership skills, managing a team, crisis management, program planning;
- working with children and youth;
- journalistic and multimedia skills;
- English and Slovenian in practice.

Work in Socialna akademija

- A work week is from Monday to Friday, in total 35 hours (9.00 – 16.00).
- Volunteers will have support from the coordinator who will be responsible for work-related tasks, the mentor who will be responsible for supporting reflection and helping them with practical aspects of living in Slovenia, and non-formal mentor who will make their integration in new environment easier.





Acommodation, food and pocket money

- Volunteers will be accommodated in two-bed rooms, in flat there will be kitchen, shower, toilet, and wi-fi. We also have a kitchen in our office space.
- Flat is located in Gorjupova 1, Ljubljana 2 km form our office space.
- Volunteers will get pocket money 4€/day (ca. 120€/month) and food money 5€/day (ca. 150€/month). They will receive money monthly.

Travel cost reimbursement

- Traveling costs will be covered according to Erasmus+ regulation up to 275€.
- The volunteer will have to provide original tickets. We will reimburse arriving travel costs in the month of arrival. For returning tickets, the volunteer will send them after returning home. Upon receiving, we will reimburse travel cost in two week time.
