PROJECT CONTEXT

Location: Kwidzyn

General information

Kwidzyn is a capital of the powiat located in Pomeranian Voivodeship on the river Liwa and even by Polish standards

Kwidzyn is an old city, and one with a rich and interesting history... Kwidzyn is a town with about 40. 000 inhabitants, with several additional thousand residing in the surrounding rural areas, located 100 km from the Baltic Sea to the south.

It is situated also about 100 km from Gdańsk, Sopot and Gdynia, which are historical and cultural destinations in Pomeranian region.

There is a good bus connection between Kwidzyn and these cities.

The development of the town is based on strong industrial structure – production of paper and electronic industry.

Kwidzyn is surrounded by beautiful and rich forests, with nature reserve and lakes. Beside that there are strong fields of non-governmental actions. We have organizations like scouts, ecological, cultural, musical and the theater. Both adults and youth will find a place for spare time and hobby development. Beside that we have cinema and theater and other cultural places like restaurants. There is also a big sport center with football pitch, basketball and tennis courts and mini golf course.

The inhabitants of Kwidzyn are mostly middle class. People work in big factories in Kwidzyn or they run their small local businesses. There is no University in Kwidzyn, that is why you can find here mostly youth till 19 years old and adults over 25. Target group of the projects are citizens of Kwidzyn, students, family with children and pensioners. We work in all the city, directly working with different organizations. Headquarter of our organization is situated in the center of the city. Next to the old town, shopping center, park, restaurants and churches.

Volunteer will be accommodated in the rented apartment, 10 - 30 min walk from the office. There will be a shared bedroom, kitchen and bathroom for a volunteer.



Our 12 months ESC programs allow young people to experience living abroad whilst learning and contributing to a world, with support from the European Solidarity Corps programme. This is a great opportunity to join meaningful work and learning while your food, accommodation, travelling, pocke' money, insurance and mentorship are covered.

The main missions for the volunteer will be:

- 1. Educational and pedagogical activities plus promoting non-formal education methods,
- 2. European cultural openness and various forms of cultural education,
- 3. Joint project with the 16 volunteers in the 8 different hosting places.

The volunteer will work full time with the team of the Hosting Organization from Monday to Friday, on minimum 32-hour week basis. They might be asked to take part in evening gatherings with the students and locals. From time to time, the volunteer will have the opportunity to work in associated schools, kindergartens and local institutions with the other ESC volunteers in order to build a common projects and events.

We are looking for motivated candidates with a proactive, creative and problem-solving attitude, at least basic knowledge of English and organisational skills. A creative persons who enjoys speaking in front of a crowd and who is motivated to develop events and activities that strengthen the integration between polish and international students, kids, youngsters. Ready to work with people in different age, not scared of daily routine.


The volunteer must be mature, open-minded and able to work based on his/her own initiative, but also work in close cooperation with the staff at the project. The volunteer should be prepared to work also in the evenings and sometimes weekends – depends of events. Much of the work, a volunteer will be doing, is to encourage young people to participate in civic life as well as to develop their personality and European identity.

All volunteer's task: providing workshops according to volunteers skills, experiences, interests (movie, handcraft, IT, acting, ecology, languages, others), organizing after school activities for youngsters – leading language group, intercultural learning activities – culture evenings, and summer and winter camps for children and so on.

The Special School for Work Adaptation – 2 spots, 1 male

Founded in 1957 the Special School in Kwidzyn main goal is to prepare teenage pupils with disabilities for work and independent life, using a diverse curriculum in addition to traditional class like math and writing class etc, we have practical class (cooking, gardening, etc) and therapy class (horse therapy, physical therapy, etc), sport class (swimming pool, basketball, etc), and creative class (drawing, pottery, etc).

The main aim of the volunteers is helping with the organization and conducting educational, rehabilitative and caring activities with the teenagers with light, moderate, significant and deeper mental handicap as well as the ones with coupled disabilities as well as giving intellectual support in the young people everyday duties.

Suggested activities for the volunteers:

- helping a teacher with varied educational and caring activities; assisting kids in daily routine;
- taking care and assisting during the curricular and extracurricular classes: at the swimming-pool, hypo therapy, after-school clubs, hikes and school trips, hydrotherapy, rehabilitation during mobility improvement classes;
- preparing various didactic materials for classes;
- giving support to the teacher and students in the Adapting to Work classes pottery, cleaning, gardening, cooking;
- helping in the organization of the out of school activities and events (the scouts, competitions etc.).





Kindergarten in Gardeja Village – 1 spots

Kindergartens are functioning as a caring, educational and instructive centres. They are the places where healthy and disabled kids have fun together. They provides every child the opportunity to have fun and learn in a safe, friendly place where everything is tailor-made for their needs and development. It shapes the emotional resilience in children with different physical and intellectual capabilities. Kindergartens are building children's knowledge about the social world.

Volunteer will take part in the following activities:

- participating and helping in daily work: preparing activities and games for kids;
- helping during lunch, in daily hygiene, accompanying and watching after the kids during the walks and while staying in public places(cinemas, museums, theatres etc.);
- helping kids get dressed for outside activities;
- helping the assistant during breakfast (setting and clearing the table, giving food to the children)
- Lead games and activities for children, music classes, -playing with the children;
- attend and conduct classes in English;
- assist in working with children with disabilities;
- decorate the school before any programme;
- taking part in ESC promoting projects, workshops, presentations.

SUPRA Football Association – 1 spot, male

Association was created with a passion for sport, mainly for football. Activists become physical education teachers and qualified trainers working in schools and public units in Kwidzyn. People who want to work with young people and infect their passion for movement, sport and football in particular. The task of our association is to train young footballers in Kwidzyn and to promote this sport among children and youth. As part of our work, we conduct football training, take care of children during ongoing classes, organize football matches and tournaments, and take part in them.

Volunteer will take part in the following activities:

- periodic football training for children and youth aged 7-16 from September to June, in various aged groups, trainings in English language; work starts at 15:00 till 22:00
- summer trainings and outdoor activities, winter trainings in the sport hall;
- seasonal competitions organized between Kwidzyn sports clubs and other towns;
- International kids day an integration meeting for children and young people playing in the club with their parents the meeting aims to integrate and fun. The meeting is directed to 300 people.
- a summer camp that lasts 7 days or longer, organized out of Kwidzyn.





FLOW Foundation – 1 spot

Start where you are. Use what you have. Do what you can! - this is motto of organisation. Flow Foundation work as a Crisis Intervention Centre and place of social integration of children and youth from difficult environments. It works as a place where we citizens can always turn to for help in various crisis situations. Delivers activities such as legal advices, psychological consultations, social counselling or parenting skills workshops but also individual corrective and educational programs for people using domestic violence are developed and implemented and educational workshops for various groups (pregnant minors, the disabled, the elderly).

Volunteers work might be:

- helping in all education activities, with professional educators and social workers,
- working with the young people on the field of art, ecology or sports and others,
- organizing work with the youth on the field of developing hobbies, interests, organizing leisure time activities for the youngsters; language clubs (usually English) for children and adults as well;
- organizing and coordinating simple works like gardening, repairing things etc., art classes, supervisions.
- office work and individual ideas
