Background:

ZMINA Human Rights Centre (ZMINA) engages heavily in international advocacy in order to advance our key organizational and human rights priorities. International and regional human rights bodies, multilateral institutions, and other forums provide opportunities to strengthen international human rights norms and standards and establish human rights mechanisms. Since Russia's invasion of Ukraine in February 2022, these bodies also provide avenues to promote and push for accountability on war crimes, crimes against humanity, and severe human rights violations.
