Description: Urgent Repair Works at the retaining walls of the House of Scientists in Odesa (Ukraine)

The United Nations Educational, Science and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) hereby invite qualified companies to submit sealed tenders as follows:

Since the full-scale invasion of Ukraine on 24 February 2022, the repeated attacks to Odesa have significantly damaged or endangered a consequential part of the urban historic fabric of the city. Between August and September 2023, the UNESCO International Expert Mission to Assess Damage to Cultural and Religious Sites in Odesa assessed the damage to 47 cultural buildings that have been impacted since July 2023.

Among these, the Odesa House of Scientists, located at Str. Sabaneiv Mist, 4, which lies within the World Heritage property 'The Historic Centre of Odesa'. The Odesa House of Scientists, built in 1832 and designed by G. Torricelli, is a significant historical monument. Over the years, the two-story building has undergone several interventions, preserving its authentic decoration and unique museum exhibits. It serves as a venue for various cultural and scientific events. The building holds substantial artistic, historical, and cultural value for the city and the country.

As the UNESCO in Ukraine, as part of the project documentation to implement urgent interventions, preventive conservation, stabilization and consolidation works to reactivate essential functions of built heritage and cultural institutions at-risk and critically affected by the war across Ukraine, will supports enhancement of urgent protective measures for Odesa historic and cultural property due to damage occurred on 20 and 23 July 2023, by conducting repair works at the retaining walls of the House of Scientists in Odesa (Ukraine).

Under the direct supervision of the UNESCO Antenna in Ukraine the contractor shall perform the following works:

1. Repair and dismantling works for the first retaining wall (along Viiskovy Uzvis Str.)
2. Repair and dismantling works for the second retaining wall (along the Sabanieiev Bridge side)
3. Repair and construction works for the third retaining wall (in the inner garden of House of Scientists)
4. Repairment and construction works of the fourth retaining wall (adjacent to the neighboring site which is located to the north of the House of Scientists)
5. Debris removal

Duration of the contract: 3 months

Detailed information and supporting documents shall be provided separately, to bidders expressing their interest. Interested bidders are encouraged to request the full solicitation documents by contacting procurement.kyiv@unesco.org.

The site visit will take place in on the premises of the House of Scientists, in Odesa, on 10 July 2025 and will be followed by a clarification meeting on 16 July, 2025, at 11.00 Kyiv time, providing additional information on the bidding.

Each bidder shall bear the cost of his/her site visit and of attending such meeting.
