2	Infrastructure Support	Maintain the analytical infrastructure in Google BigQuery and Electronic Databases (EDB); ensure the integrity and archiving of historical databases.
3	Data Visualization	Integrate datasets into visualization systems to support project analytics.
4	System Adaptation	Ensure timely reconciliation and submission of imported data into the DATIM system.
5	Technical Coordination	Prepare datasets for analysis and participate in technical meetings with program, grants, and M&E teams.
