1	22-05-2026	Of the total 150 participants, how many are expected to be international staff and how many Ukrainian staff? How many participants are expected to attend the two-day course for security staff, and how many are expected to attend the one-day course?	Out of the total 150 participants, it is estimated that approximately 13 participants, at maximum, will be international staff members, while the remaining participants will be Ukrainian nationals. Regarding the security staff component, there are currently 27 security staff members in the country, with the number expected to increase to 29 in the near future. Of the current 27 security staff members, 27 are Ukrainian nationals, who also speak English, while one staff member from security component is international.
2	22-05-2026	Please clarify whether, in cases where our instructors previously served in the military and performed duties as instructors during their service, it would be acceptable to provide an official explanatory letter from the company outlining the situation? Obtaining official letters or supporting documents directly from military units is extremely difficult due to confidentiality restrictions. However, the instructors possess relevant certifications and completed specialised courses related to drone piloting and counter-drone operations, which will be included in Bidder's proposal documentation. At the same time, it is unable to share military IDs or other military service documents due to the confidential nature of such information.	Bidder may provide this information in the form of an official letter explaining the situation. In addition, kindly ensure that all relevant information regarding the proposed team member's experience, including specific military-related experience relevant to the requirements of the training, is clearly outlined in the individual's CV. The submitted information and supporting documentation will be taken into consideration during the evaluation process. Should any additional clarification be required, DRC will contact Bidder accordingly.
