REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (RFI) - UA26NF054 for Cargo

Vans Closing on 29.06.2026 at 18:00 hrs (Kyiv Time)

A. Background

1. The United Nations World Food Programme hereinafter referred to as the "WFP", with its Headquarters located in Via C.G. Viola, 68/70, 00148 Rome, Italy is the leading humanitarian organization saving lives and changing lives, delivering food assistance in emergencies and working with communities to improve nutrition and build resilience by assisting almost 100 million people in around 83 countries each year. About 17,000 people work for the organization, most of them in remote areas, directly serving the hungry poor.
2. The WFP Country Office in Kyiv seeks to procure **10 armoured cargo vans with the highest available certified protection level for the passenger cabin**, including ballistic, fragmentation, and, where available, top-attack protection. The armoured vans will be used for food transportation operations in Ukraine, specifically for carrying boxes weighing approximately 12 kg each.
3. Technical Requirements of Armoured Cargo Vans:
 1. Vehicle Specifications:
 - Vehicle type: Armoured cargo van
 - Quantity: 10 units
 - Body size: Minimum L2/H1 or equivalent
 - Engine: Minimum 2.0L (diesel or petrol)
 - Drive type: 2WD or 4WD
 - Transmission: Automatic or manual
 - Payload capacity: Approx. 3,500 kg after armouring
 - Dimensions: Approx. 2050 × 2534 × 5998 mm (flexible range acceptable)
 2. Protection Requirements (Cabin Only – Mandatory)
 - Armor design: Fully armoured passenger cabin, including floor, roof, side walls, doors and frames, front and rear panels, and all glazing (windows).
 - Ballistic protection: Highest available certified level (BR7 or equivalent, if available).
 - Spall protection: Maximum anti-spall protection for occupants.
 - Fragmentation protection: Certified level; specify applicable test standard.
 - Certification: Ballistic protection equivalent to DSTU 3975:2000 Protection Level PZSA-4 or recognized international standards (EN 1063 BR6/BR7, NIJ Level III/IV, STANAG 4569 Level 2-3). Suppliers shall provide valid test reports and certificates.
 3. Optional
 - Cargo compartment: Armouring not required; suppliers may propose optional solutions (e.g., floor or roof protection).
 4. Additional requirements
 - Ballistic test reports: Copies of valid test reports and certificates
 - Warranty: Warranty period for armoured protection
 - Production lead time: Manufacturing and delivery schedule
 - Delivery Terms: Kyiv
 - Delivery lead time: as soon as possible

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4. WFP invites suppliers operating on the relevant market to provide information about the Armored Cargo Vans they offer.
5. WFP also welcomes suppliers who have Cargo Vans without armouring and to confirm the availability and to where shall WFP send these Cargo Vans to be Armoured.

B. The purpose of this RFI

6. The purpose of this RFI is to gain a more detailed understanding of the supply market and existing solutions both to identify suppliers with experience in a particular area and to gain knowledge about Armored Cargo Vans.
7. After the deadline for submission of responses has passed, WFP will review responses received and will notify eligible participants of the outcomes of this initiative.

C. How to prepare and submit your response to Request for Information

8. In order to participate, companies/organizations are required to provide the following:
